CRIME AND PUNISHMENT

Ten Most Wanted 1970

Lawrence Plamondon. Crime: Plamondon, the "Minister of Defense" of the White Panther Party, was accused of bombing a CIA office in Ann Arbor, Michigan. Later arrested and convicted.

Bernadine Rae Dohrn. Crime: Wanted for mob action, riot, and conspiracy in a bomb plot in Flint, Michigan, and a series of violent demonstrations in Chicago put on by the Weathermen faction of the SDS. Government dropped the bombing indictment against her in 1973 and her name was removed from the most wanted list.

Hubert Geroid Brown. Crime: H. Rap Brown, as he was called, was a black militant who headed the Student National Coordinating Committee. He was charged with avoiding prosecution for arson and incitement to riot. Shot and captured by the NYC police after an aborted holdup in 1971.

Angela Yvonne Davis. Crime: Wanted in connection with the murders of a judge and three prison inmates during an attempt to free "Soledad Brother: George Jackson in Marin County California. Two months after she was named as the third woman on the most wanted list, the black, beautiful brilliant, self avowed communist was arrested in New York. She was acquitted by an all-white jury after a trial that lasted more than 3 months.

Karleton Armstrong, Dwight A. Armstrong, Leo F. Burt and David S. Fine. Crime: All four were sought for sabotage, destruction of government property and conspiracy in the bombing of a University of Wisconsin building that killed a researcher and injured several others. They were all members of the SDS. Only one of them was captured, poor Karleton, in 1972.

Susan Edith Saxe and Katherine A. Power. Crime: Members of an unnamed revolutionary group according to the FBI, they were charged in the death of a Boston police officer following a bank robbery. Turns out that they were just bank robbers. One caught, one still at large.

Amazing how crimes have changed, isn't it?

MAJOR NEWS EVENTS IN 1970

Census Bureau reports that the United States population is 203,211,926

Many headlines dealt with the hijacking of aircraft; 65 hijackings occurred

January 5, 1970--Joseph "Jock" Jablonski, the defeated reform candidate for president of the United Mine Workers Union, his wife and daughter are found murdered in their home in Clarksville, Pa. W.A.

"Tony" Boyle, the UMW president was convicted of ordering the assassination 4 years later.

January 11, 1970--Professional football achieves its largest viewing audience when the Kansas City Chiefs defeat the Minnesota Vikings 23-7 in the Super Bowl.

February 20, 1970--The Chicago Seven--Abbie Hoffman, Jerry Rubin, Tom Hayden, Rennie Davis, David Dillinger, Lee Weiner and John Froines--were convicted of conspiracy to cross state lines and instigate a riot at the Democratic Convention of 1968. In time, all of the charges against the defendants were dropped by higher courts.

April 30, 1970--American troops begin what President Nixon describes as an incursion into Cambodia.

May 4, 1970--National Guardsmen kill 4 students at Kent State University during a campus protest against the Cambodian invasion.

May 5, 1970--A nationwide student strike, supported on the majority of the campuses in the country protested the extension of the war and killing of the students at Kent State. Michigan State University shuts down for the first time ever.

May 14, 1970--Two black students at Jackson State College in Mississippi are killed by police firing on a dormitory.

June 14, 1970--608 members of the Dearborn High School Class of 1970 receive their diplomas during a blistering hot ceremony held at McIntyre Field.

June 27, 1970--Marxist Salvador Allende is elected President of Chile.

October 15, 1970--West Gate Bridge over the Yarra River in Melbourne, Australia collapses; 35 workers are killed.

November 12, 1970--Bangladesh is hit with a murderous cyclone. Winds whipped along at 150 mph, dragging in their vacuum wake a 20' wave of water that devastates the country. Loss of life estimated at a million or more.

A MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Before submitting my resignation as President of the Class, effective immediately to avoid impeachment proceedings if the Reunion events don't come off very well, I want to comment on how the Reunion came about.

Having aspired to and having attained that high office and having chosen to remain in Dearborn, I would occasionally run into fellow classmates over the past couple of years who would inquire "What about a 20 Year Reunion?" Momentarily stunned by such reminders of my fiduciary obligation to periodically throw big parties for 1970 DHS grads, I would forget to immediately appoint that person to the position of honorary Class President and Chairperson of the 20 Year Reunion Committee. Time kept on slippin', slippin', slippin', into the future until late last year when, while shopping at ACO for a ballpeen hammer, I found myself diving behind a stack of peat moss to avoid seeing a classmate who I just knew was going to ask, "What about a 20 Year Reunion?" Not that I did not wish to see this person, mind you, I just didn't want to face the embarrassment of explaining my own inaction on the subject. It was time, reluctantly, to move.

It is my good fortune to still be in regular contact with many of those with whom I graduated. I'm not at all certain that they felt it to be their good fortune when I contacted them about serving on a Reunion Committee. They nevertheless agreed to help out. I am, of course, saddened that it is unlikely that any of them will ever speak to me again, at least not until the 30 Reunion is over and done with.

The committee first met in late November, 1989. In what seemed like a good idea at the time, we signed a contract with a Reunion company to put the thing on for us. Then we found out what they cost. At just about any place we might have had the Reunion, their services would cost anywhere from \$17.00 to \$20.00 more per ticket. This included a DJ, cash bar, no band, no pre-party, no picnic, no decorations and no yearbook. We said "no way." We're not a bunch of communists who frown on the profit motive, but this seemed out of line--gouging, if you will--akin to what 7-11 charges for baby formula at 2:30 in the morning.

So, we dumped them. Imbued with fervor fueled by several "pops" at the Trail Bar, this committee of Pioneers voted to blaze the Reunion trail by ourselves. And that'll teach us to socialize before taking important votes.

The first task was to find a place to hold the Reunion and select a date for it. Both choices were relatively easy. Because we were slow in getting out of the chute on the planning, our site selections were limited. Our first 257 choices were already booked. We could have gotten into the Hyatt or the Ritz-Carleton but they were a bit too pricey. Indeed, when we read about President Bush's \$1,000 a plate dinner at the Ritz a few months ago, we wondered if he had covered his costs. We settled on the Park Lane Station because it was reasonably priced and kind of a neat set up with the outdoor patio. Its most attractive feature was that it was available. We were not happy with having to use two rooms to host the Reunion, but we had little choice but to weather the complaining that will arise as result of it.

Picking the date was easy. We all thought it should be in the summer and that it should be held during Homecoming Weekend for the benefit of those who have left the Dearborn nest.

The issue that received greatest attention was ticket pricing. We wanted to keep it reasonable and believe me, we have. We approached the pricing question by first deciding what we wanted to do. Pre-parties, picnics, yearbooks--these all seem to be staples of most 20 or 25 year reunions we had heard about. Some classes, notably those that have had professional reunion planners handling the event, would charge separately for the events and the yearbook. We thought the wiser course to be to include everything in one ticket price. We totaled up the cost of everything, mailing, printing, food, and entertainment. We hypothesized that approximately 300 people would buy tickets. We divided the gross total by 300 and came up with the ticket price.

It has become apparent that we neglected to consider several miscellaneous expenses in our calculations. And it wasn't until a couple of weeks ago that we realized that we would fall just short of the 300 mark. We're close, but as of this writing, it appears that there will be about 280 attendees. So, in keeping with the highest of entrepreneurial spirit, the committee decided to sell patron ads for the yearbook to supplement the budget. The collective sigh of relief you heard last week was the committee when we discovered that, yes, a number of people and businesses would be glad to buy a "patron" ad in the rather limited circulation yearbook. It appears as if we will be able to cover the cost of the committee's last meeting in Nassau.

Without doubt, the biggest challenge facing the committee was compiling a mailing list. Ann MacLean and Karen Lusky Scherer were chosen to handle this because they didn't attend the meeting when this was decided. They worked hard to develop an initial mailing list of

about 400 names. We were pleased that that meant only 200 classmates had to be listed on the missing list. We didn't mean to suggest that those who were on it had dropped out of sight, we just didn't know where they were. We were even a little embarrassed by some of the people who were on it. For example, it seemed that everyone in the class, except for us, knew where Bruce Campbell was. Where the hell have we been, we asked ourselves when about 200 classmates provided us with Bruce's address.

By this time, if you're still reading this, you must be wondering, "Why is this in here?" "What is he babbling about?" I know I wonder these things. The point of this letter, which seems to have gotten lost along the way, is to acknowledge and thank all those who are responsible for putting the Reunion together.

Russell Raftary, Karen Lusky Scherer and I were the ringleaders of this merry band. I want to say this about these two: Russell's energy and optimism know no boundaries and I can flat out say that if he wasn't involved the Reunion may not have happened. Karen? You remember Karen. She was the one who planned our Senior Trip to Silver Lake and then didn't go. She has probably put more tedious hours in than anybody getting the mailing lists and yearbook together. She and her husband Ron (DHS '67) have put in yeoman service. The assistance of the rest of the folks has been invaluable. Thank you one and all.


EDITOR'S NOTE

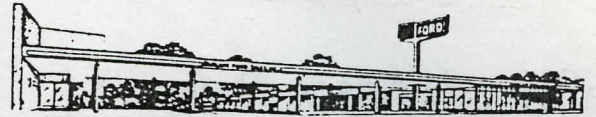

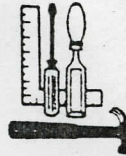

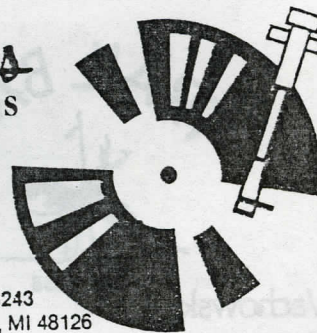
