Every individual contributed his or her own to make the Senior Class a class to be long remembered. Following the beat of a different drummer is what built our class, and is what will make our future. We will carry on.

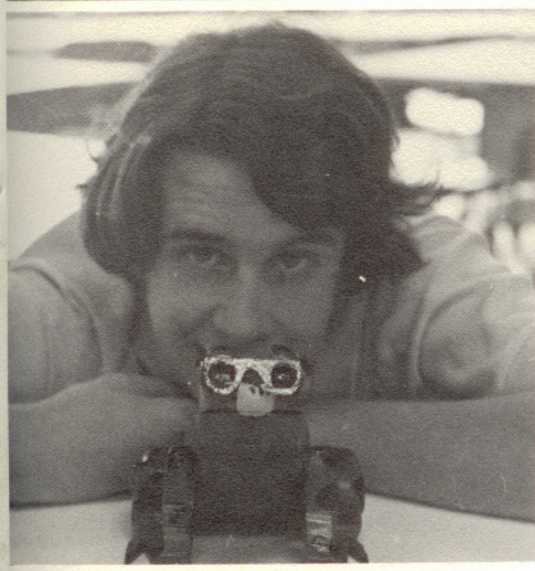
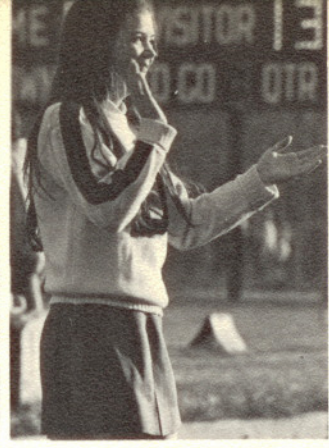
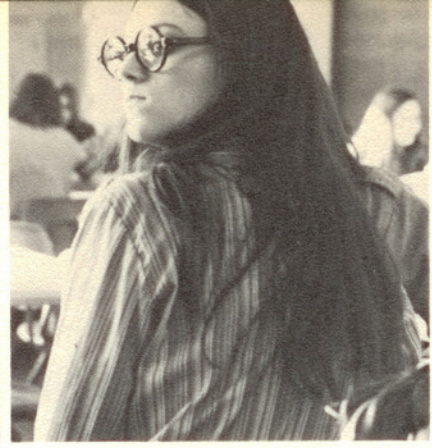

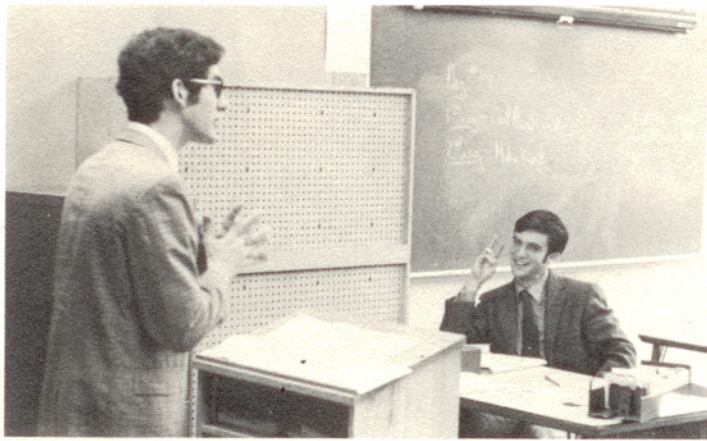
Debaters Fast Talk Their Way Through Season

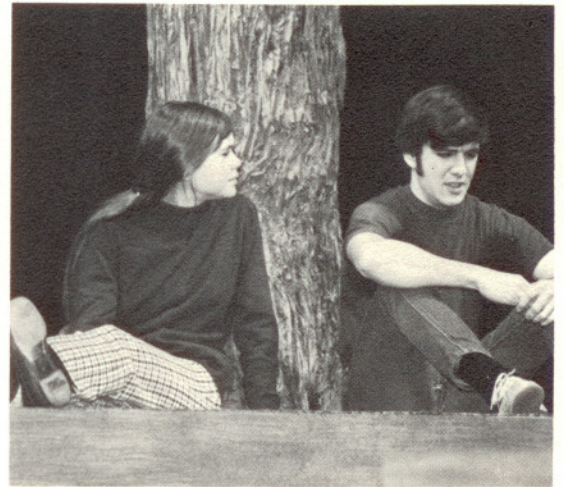

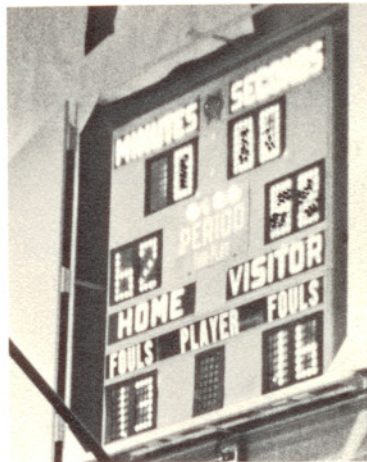

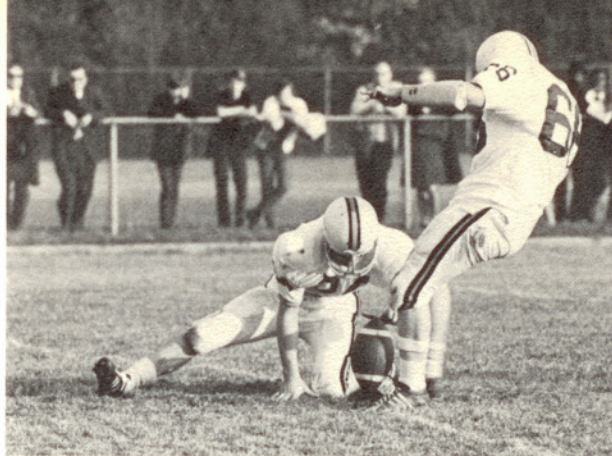

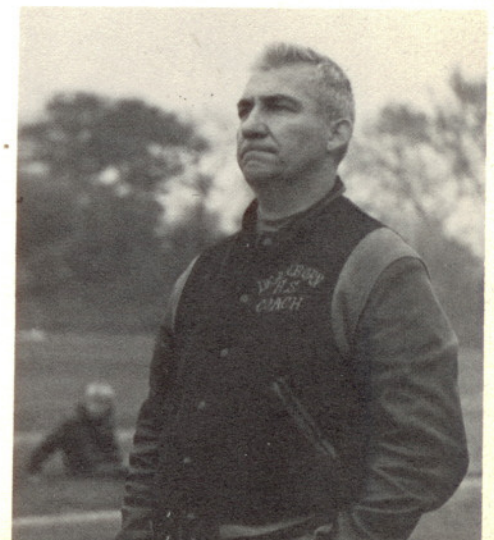

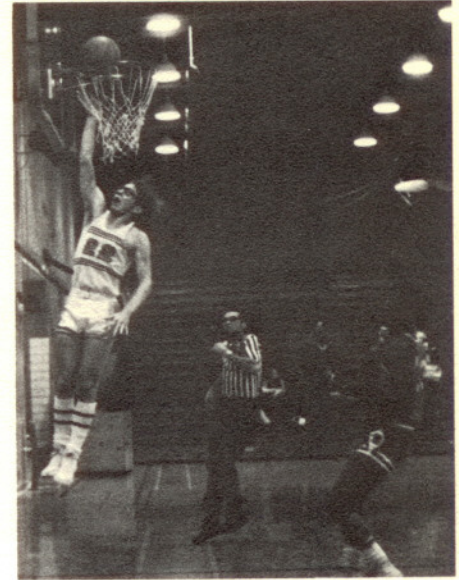

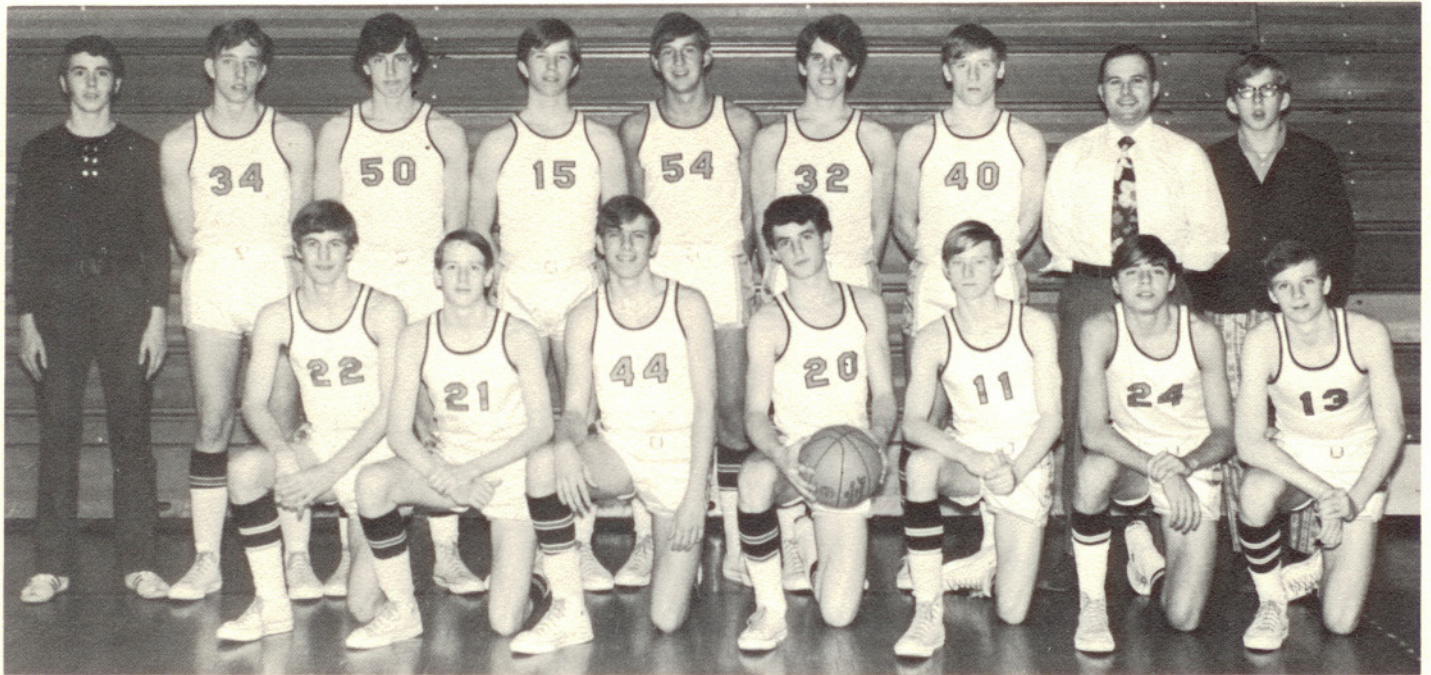

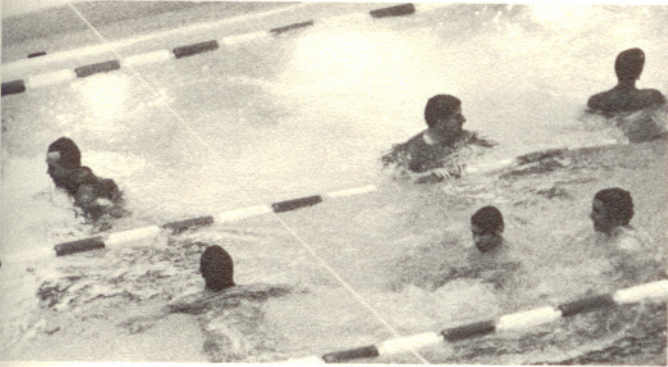

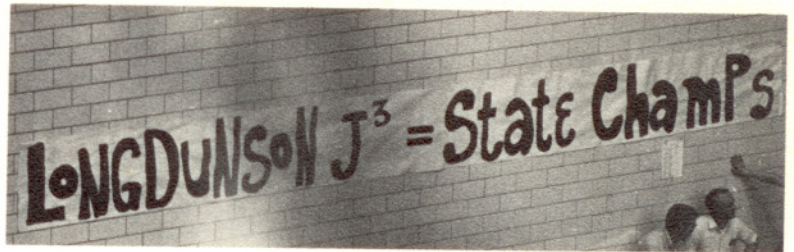


Dearborn Swimmers Win State Meet

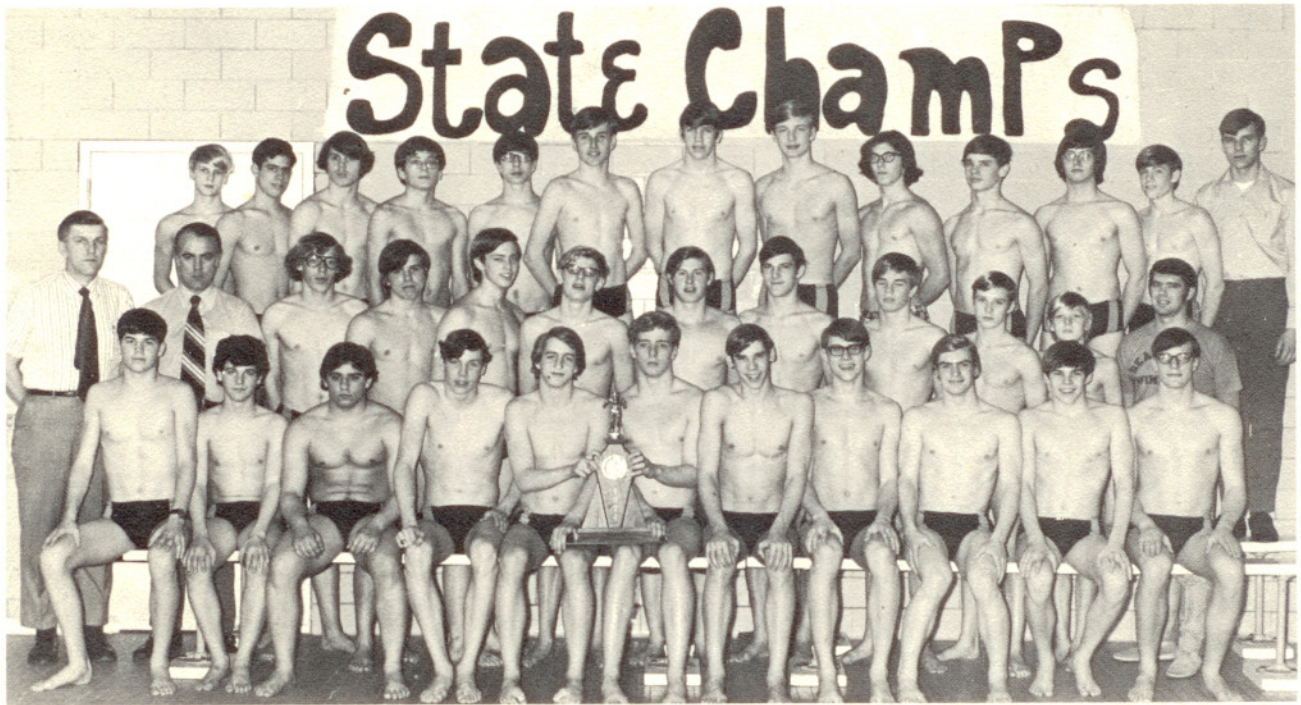

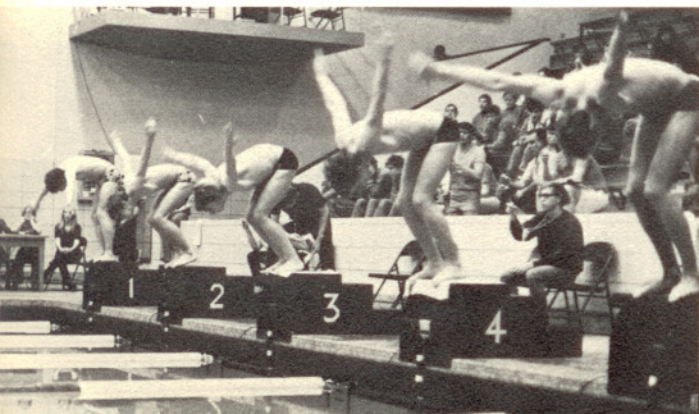

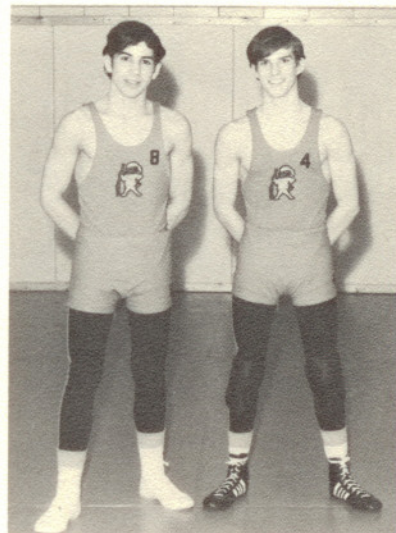

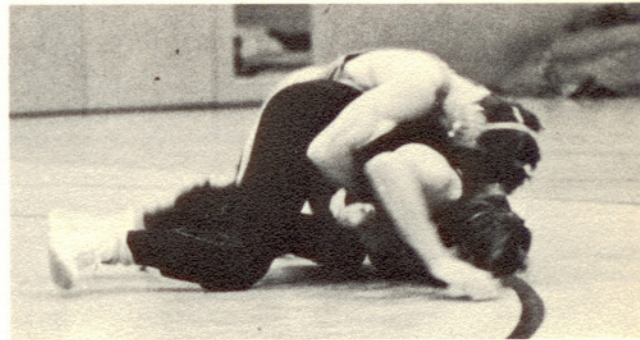

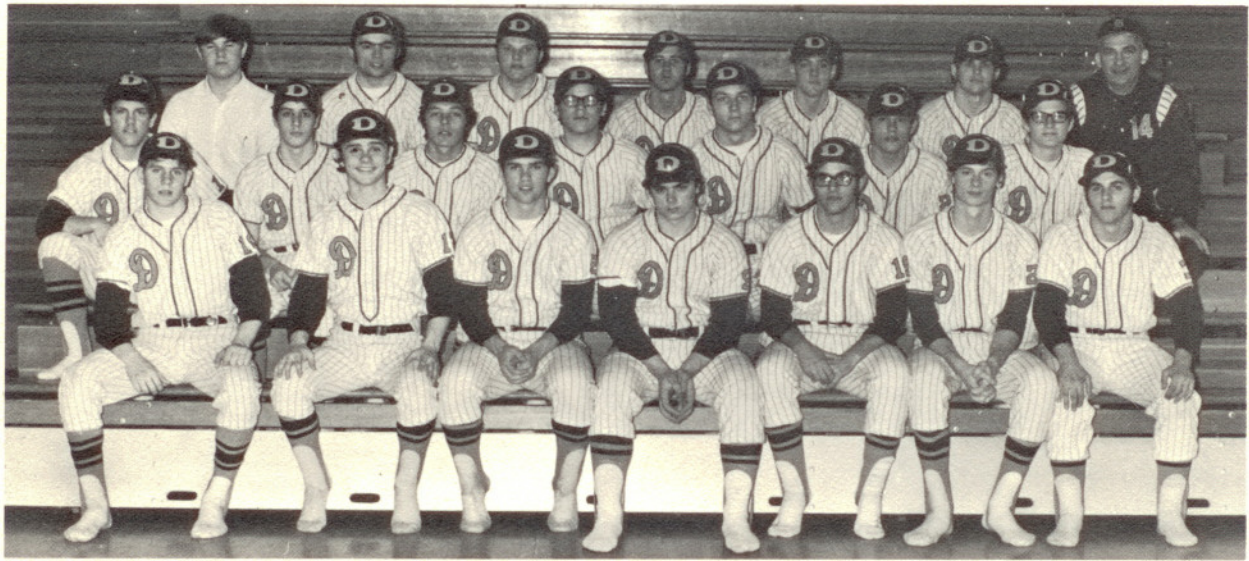

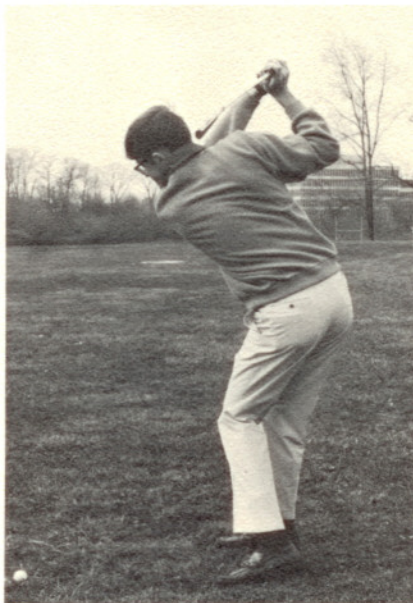

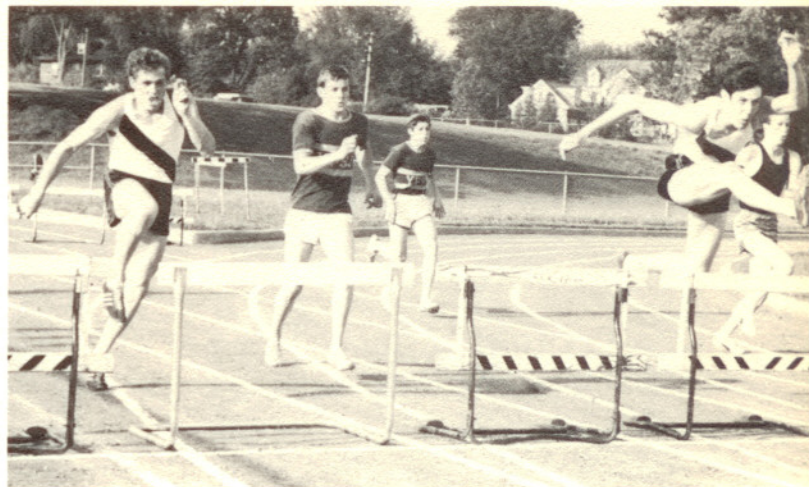

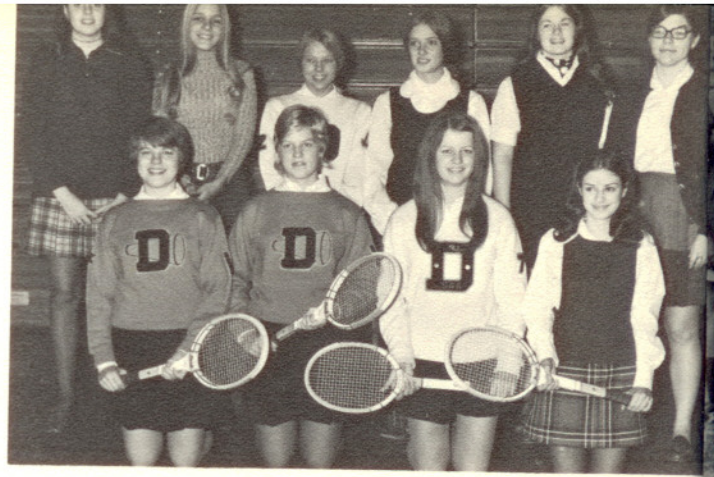
