ON THE SET

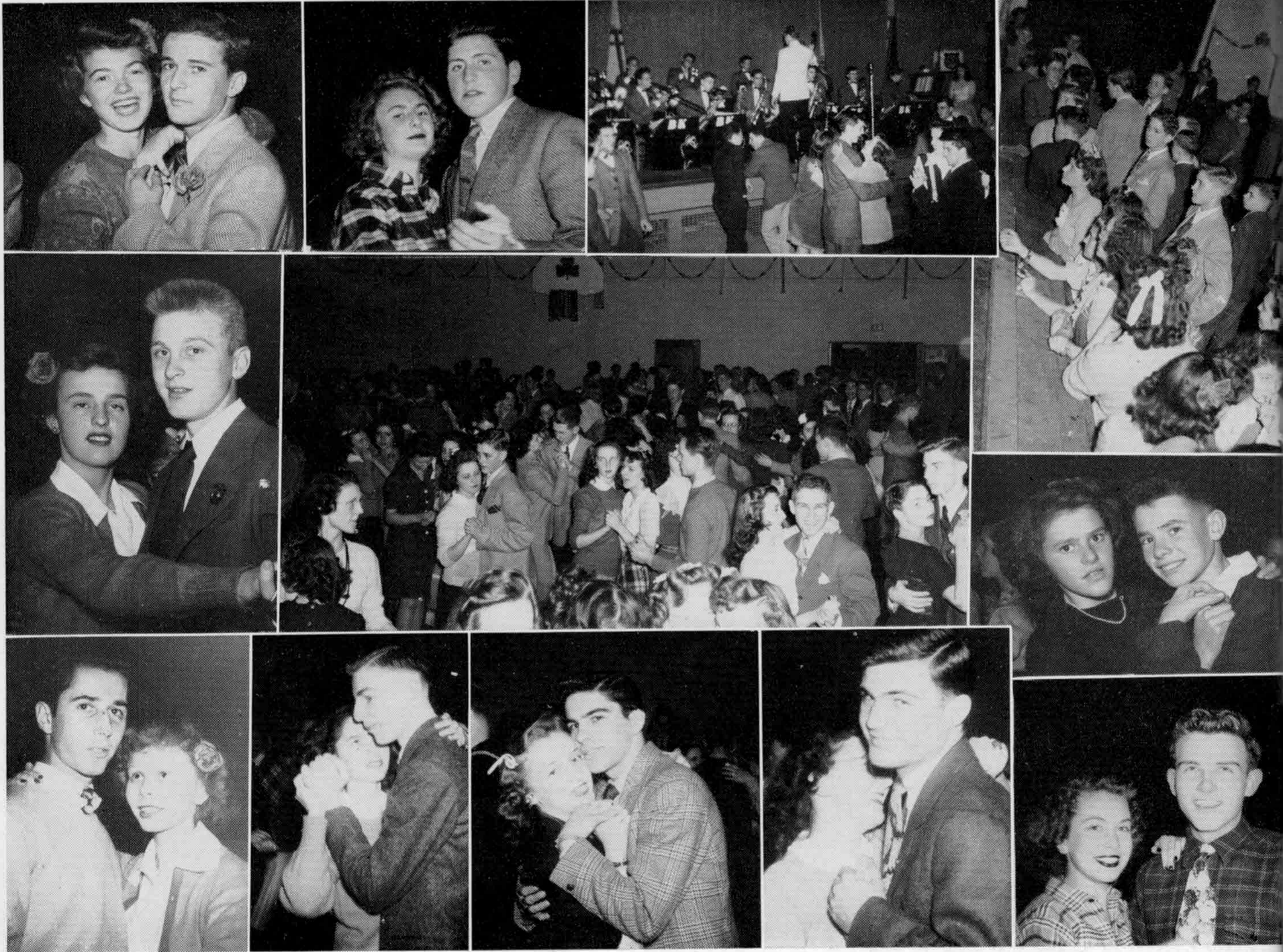

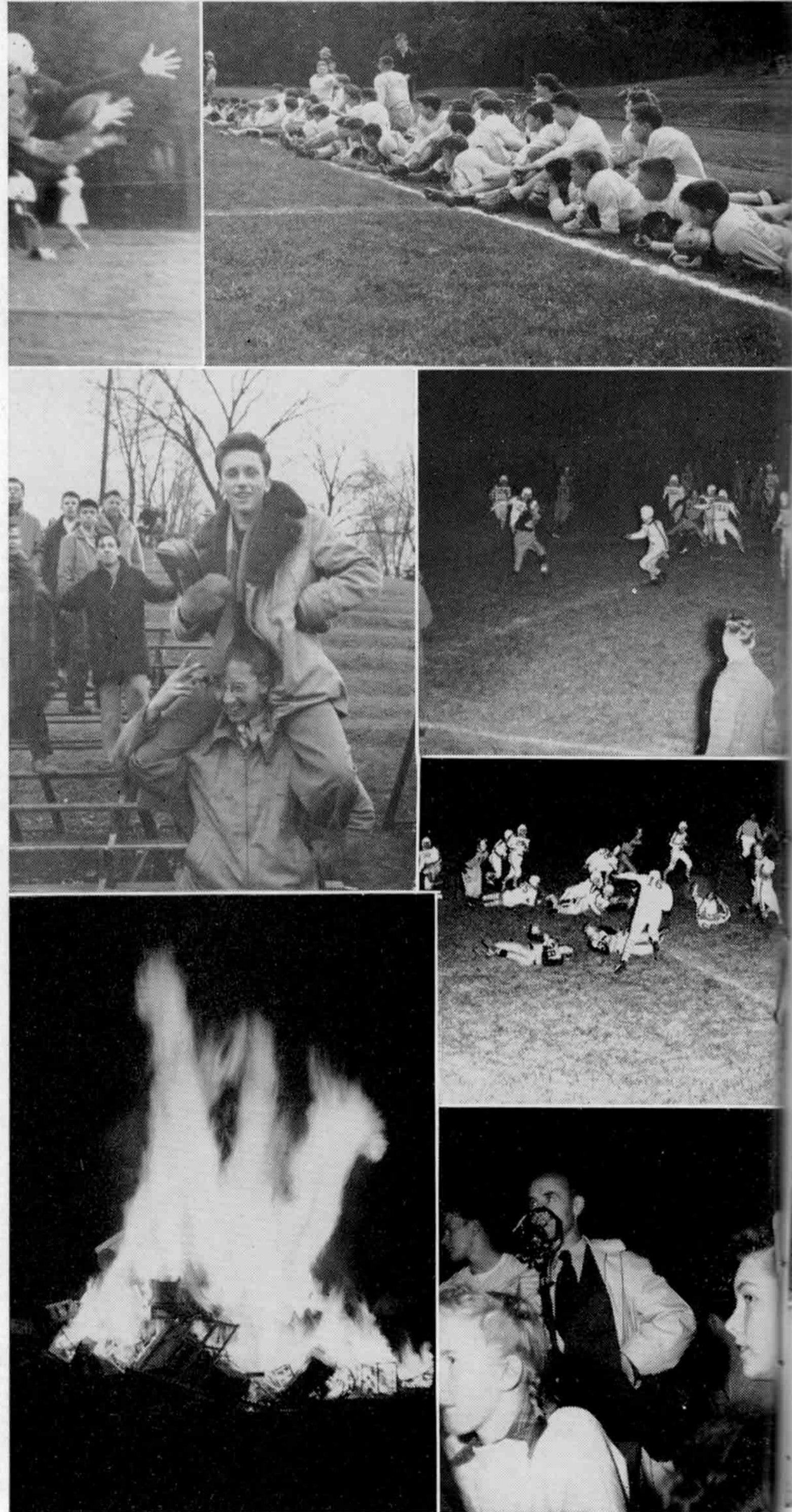
WE DIDN'T WIN SO MANY GAMES
